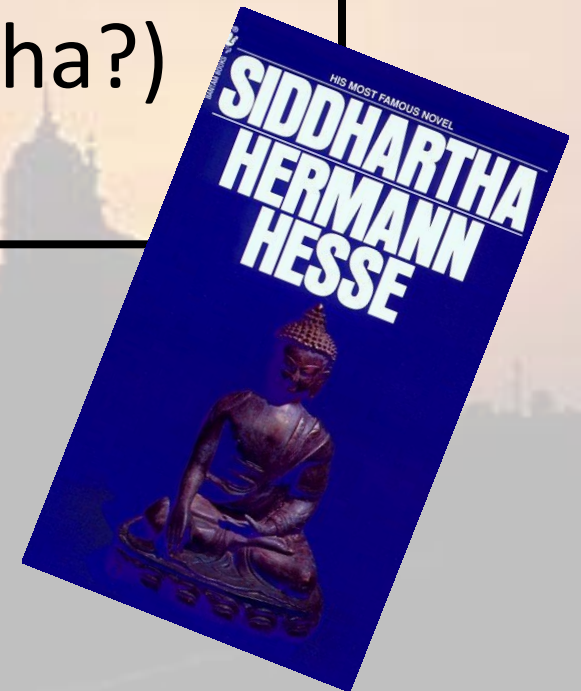

Illustrious -- adjective

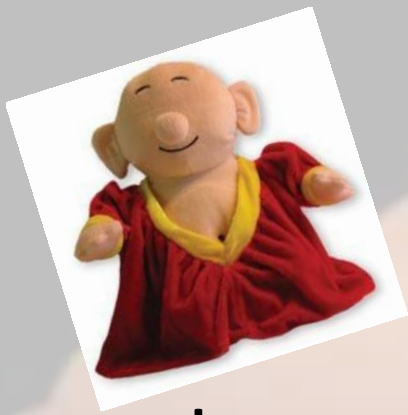


notably or brilliantly outstanding
because of dignity or achievements or
actions

Alms -- noun (pl.)

charity; something (as money or food)
given freely





Ascetics -- noun (pl.)

those who practice strict self-denial as a
measure of personal and spiritual
discipline

Countenance -- noun

look or expression on one's face;
demeanor; mental composure



Salvation -- noun



deliverance from sin; deliverance from
danger or difficulty

Loophole -- noun

a means of escape (from an idea, text,
contract...)



Enlightened -- adjective



freed from ignorance; based on a full
comprehension of the problems
involved

Imperturbable -- adjective

marked by extreme calm; serene



Candid -- adjective

free from bias or prejudice
(not posed or rehearsed)





Erudition -- noun

extensive knowledge acquired chiefly
from books

Ardent -- adjective

characterized by an expression of
zealous (passionate) support or
activity



Courtesan -- noun

a prostitute with courtly, wealthy, or
upper-class clients
